



Fire Sprinkler Safety

Suites at the Bentley have the following types of fire sprinklers:

Ceiling Sprinkler



Wall Sprinkler



Balcony Sprinkler



While fire sprinklers are an essential safety feature which will quickly extinguish fires and prevent them from spreading, they also present the risk of causing serious and costly water damage if they are mishandled. If a sprinkler is struck even lightly by an object, the glass valve in the sprinkler will very likely break, setting off the sprinkler and releasing a high pressure stream of water into your suite. Should this happen, considerable water damage to both your suite and others will certainly occur. Therefore, residents must be extremely careful when working or painting near a sprinkler and must make sure not to lean anything on a wall near a sprinkler or place anything on a shelf or cabinet near a sprinkler. Also, since the sprinklers are heat activated, never use a hair dryer, heat gun, or any other heat generating device near a sprinkler. Most importantly, you must **never hang anything from a sprinkler.**
